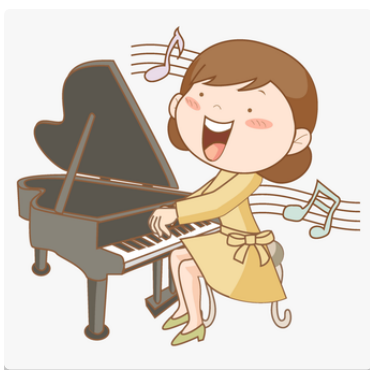
Badminton Club for Grade 4 & 5 Students

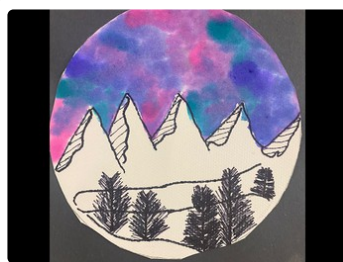
