




SUMMARY

- improved student perception of engagement and interest in learning (grade 4 & 5 responses)
- collaborative structures allow for strong learning across our team of professionals; teachers work together to share new instructional strategies and learn about new technologies to leverage learning
- celebrating the diversity of our student population through school events

ENGAGING OUR COMMUNITY

- increased and active participation in school council; growth beyond eight consistent participants
- providing ongoing opportunity for parent and student feedback (surveys, weekly Smore newsletters with response options, Open House planning)
- improved community connections with business partners across Taber

COMMENTARY ON OUR RESULTS (PUTTING IT INTO CONTEXT)

- increased participation in local assurance survey but very low participation on provincial survey
- address language barrier for many families to engage in meaningful feedback; need to increase opportunities for LGM and ESL families to engage in surveys and feedback
- inconsistent attendance impacts achievement of certain students
- increased student enrollment of new families to Canada, who have language barriers and unique challenges as they settle into their new home
