RE: At Home Learning from May 7th-25th

Dear Central Families,

Due to the rise in Covid-19 cases across the province, the provincial government has determined that k-12 learning will occur at home from May 7th – May 25th. During this two-week period, families can expect students will be focusing primarily on Literacy and Numeracy. Teachers and Educational Assistants will be connecting virtually or by phone with students on a daily basis. The province has recommended about 8-10 hours worth of learning activities for students per week.

Our goal is to send most if not all of the items that students will need for their learning will be sent home at the end of the day Thursday. This includes Chromebooks for students who are choosing “virtual” or “online” learning through Google Classroom and/or Learning packages for students who choose not to access technology.

Please note that Friday, May 7th will be a Preparation day for teachers and there will be no learning and no contact from teachers. The school will be open and if there are items that need to be picked up, parents will be contacted directly.

If a virtual meeting or phone call is scheduled, the expectation is that student(s) is present or available to participate in the conference. If your child is unable to participate, please contact the school. If your child requires support during the school day teachers and educational assistants will be available by phone or virtual conference.

Students will be able to return to school for in person learning on Tuesday, May 25th after the long weekend. We are most excited and hopeful about having our students return to finish the year in person.
