Principal's Report for March 11th, 2021– School Council Meeting

1. Assurance Model Survey Highlights:
 - a. "When you think about the school division and your child(ren)'s school, what is one thing that we are doing well?"
 - i. Social Programs, Covid Measures, Collaboration, Having fun, teaching well, discipline, choosing good teachers, trying to provide the needs of each student, communication, making kids feel safe, encouraging family involvement, caring staff, inclusiveness, teaching kindness and respect...
 - b. "When you think about the school division and your child(ren)'s school, what is one thing we need to do better?"
 - i. Encouraging inclusion between LGM and non-LGM students, more hands-on learning, better communication, teaching about diversity, more books to read, less tolerance for bullying, more side help for struggling learners, longer lunch, longer recess...
2. Celebration of Learning: March 4th we kicked off our use of the platform "See Saw". The app allows students and teachers to upload learning materials/products/activities and also share with parents. We believe it's a great way to communicate about what students are learning at school. Our "analytics report" indicated that over 80% of our families joined See Saw last week. This is a platform that we will continue to use.
