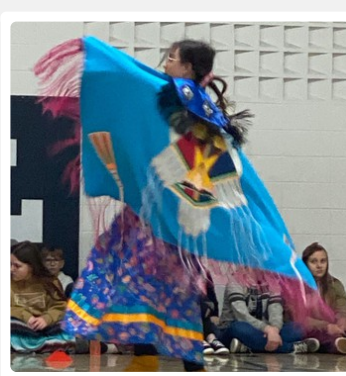
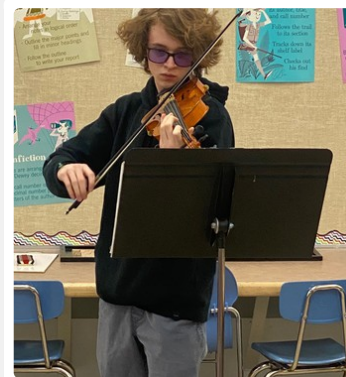




## FANTASTIC Music Appreciation Week!
